ELECTRICAL AGREEMENT

Las Animas County grants the applicant right-of-way above and along said road to applicant to place electrical lines for the transmission of electricity.

It is understood:

- The electrical lines shall be at a sufficient height so as not to interfere with the use and maintenance of said roads or right-of-way, and in no event shall the electrical lines be at a height of less than 18 feet at it's lowest point. All buried electrical lines shall be a minimum of 4' deep. Las Animas County strictly enforces these specifications and will monitor accordingly.
 - A clear zone of 10' minimum must be maintained from the County Road ditch's flow line or shoulder if no ditch exists, to any and all structures, poles etc.
 - The applicant in installing said electrical lines shall restore the road and right-of-way to their original condition. This original condition will be maintained by the applicant against settlement, wash outs etc. for a period of one (1) year from the date of the final inspection. In the event it is necessary to remove or relocate the lines because of construction or any other reason, expense shall be absorbed by the applicant.
 - Las Animas County is granting a license and not an easement. This license is irrevocable as long as the said line is used for the transmission of electricity.
 - The Applicant will maintain the installation at all times. Las Animas County, agencies thereof, officers and employees will be held harmless from any and all claims, loss and damage which may arise out of or be connected with the installation herein referred to or any work of facility connected therewith, within the area covered by this license to the extent of the negligence of the applicant, their agents, servants or employees.
 - A Traffic Control Plan, developed by a certified traffic control supervisor, must be submitted for all work performed within County road rights-of-way, or that will directly affect the travelling public. All warning signs etc. used within the County right of way must be in conformance with all applicable portions of the latest edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
 - In the event any improvements are made in the county (public) road which reasonably necessitates relocation or removal of this installation, the applicant will accomplish such relocation or removal within 90 calendar days at its own expense upon written request from Las Animas County
 - Applicant shall be responsible for any damage and associated repairs to the County Road and utilities
 - This permit is not valid until it is signed by a duly authorized representative of Las Animas County
- Colorado State Law requires that anyone who engages in any type of excavation must notify underground facility owners.

Fee schedule

- All lineal feet shall be calculated based upon the lineal feet of electrical wire installed within the County Right of Way
 - \$25.00 plus \$.50 per lineal feet
